## **SIKH COUNCIL UK ANNOUNCES GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETING ON 22<sup>ND</sup> August 2020**

Secretary General of SCUK, Jatinder Singh has given the required notice, of four weeks, to all General Assembly Members of an extraordinary meeting of the SCUK General Assembly to be held, on 22nd August 2020. Further details and agenda will be sent shortly.

Jatinder Singh was approached by GA and EC members requesting an extraordinary meeting of the General Assembly. Therefore, as per the constitution, this meeting of the General Assembly **must** be convened.

Although not constitutionally required, in the interests of a positive outcome for the Sikh Council UK, the executive committee has made continuous effort to liaise and explain our constructive approach to the Board of Jathedars convenors.

### ***“11. The General Assembly***

#### *b. Functions*

*i. The General Assembly shall be the supreme policymaking and ruling body of the SCUK*

#### *vi. Meetings*

*viii. An extraordinary meeting of the General Assembly shall be convened by the Secretary General at the request of at least **one quarter of the Delegates** or at least **half of the elected members of the Executive Committee**.*

*ix. The Secretary General shall provide all Affiliated Organisations at least a four-week notification of a General Assembly meeting “*
